Class 3: Sophia, for being very enthusiastic about everything, including the play and the sporting event last week.

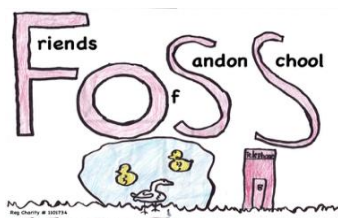
Writers of the week
