

Sandon School Homework Guidelines 2019-2020

Reading is incredibly important and your child should have daily exposure to books – this can be them reading to you or you reading to them. Children will have opportunities to read with adults at school and will have the opportunity to quiz on AR books most days, not every single day.

Fluency in Maths comes from regular number work. It would be incredibly beneficial to your child/children if you could practise number facts e.g. (how can you make 10 by adding two numbers?) with them.

Multiplication and its inverse, division are the keys to many aspects of maths.

It is essential that children know their multiplication tables therefore from **Year 2** they need to be practising and applying these regularly.

Order of introduction of multiplication tables:

Year 2 – 2, 5, 10

Year 3 – 3, 4, 8

Year 4 – 6, 7, 9, 11, 12

Year 5 & 6 - revision and use of all multiplication tables.
